

About the Artist

Following an early career as a painter, Seward Johns on turned his talents to the medium of sculpture. Since then, more than 450 of Johnson's life-size cast bronze figures have been featured in private collections and museums in the United States. Canada, Europe and Asia, as well as prominent places in the public realm such as Times Square and Rockefeller Center in New York City, Pacific Place in Hong Kong, Les Halles in Paris, and Via Condotti in Rome. Johnson initially became widely known for his sculptures depicting people engaged in every day activities. Johnson's desire to highlight the mundane in his Celebrating the Familiar sculpture series has brought a unique voice to the world of art in public spaces. In recent years, Johnson has enlarged a select few sculptures into dramatic monumental scale for placement in the public domain. To date, these twenty to thirty foot presences have been on view in Rome, Normandy, China, San Diego, Sarasota, New York City and Chicago.



This summer, we are thrilled to host a grand exhibition of the bronze, life-cast sculptures of Seward Johnson! This exhibition will feature works from two of his series of sculpture: *Celebrating the Familiar*, and *Beyond the Frame*.

Displayed in Westbury House and across 80 acres of inviting pathways throughout the Gardens, 36 of Johnson's works will be on view starting Father's Day weekend (June 16) through mid-September 2017. Open to the public for free with admission to The Gardens.

Don't forget to pick up an activity sheet at Westbury House to guide you through a journey in the park while learning about sculpture.
